Building 1. Block A, Lot 9

Log house with Lean-to, Mr. Brown (1922)
T. Godfrey of Coalmont (1928)
Only walls remaining 1970, mostly collapsed in 2024

Building 2. Block A, Lot 4 (on Shatford St.)

Frame House, Margaret Catlett (1922)
"The Sport Shop", Sapho Williams (Brothel 1928)
Occupied by Bill Bacon in 1953
Only a few boards on the ground in 2024

Building 3. Block C, Lot 5 (on Shatford St.)

Log House, Mike Gaynor (1922-1928)
Bill Bacon's Woodshed in 1953
Only a few logs remaining in 2024

Building 4. Block C, Lot 9

Frame House, Mr. Carter (1922)
Mr. McIlroy of Coalmont (1928)
Occupied by Bill Frew in 1953
No trace remaining in 2024

Building 5. Block C, Lot 3 (on Shatford St.)

Log Chicken House, Cook Estate (1922)
Log Cabin with Woodshed, Mr(s?) McLeod of Vancouver (1928)
Occupied by Bill Dixon in 1953
Occupied by Don & Chris Coomes in the 1960's
Still standing, roof mostly collapsed in 2024

Building 6. Block C, Lot 2 (on Shatford St.)

Log Building, F.P.Cook's 2nd Store (Cook Estate, closed by 1922)
"Barn", J. Martin (1928)
Walls only remaining in 1950's, only a few logs remaining in 2024

Building 7. Block C, Lot 2 (on Granite St.)

Log Building with Lean-to, Cook Estate (1922)
J.J.Malone of Princeton (1928)
Used as Warehouse & Brothel (dates unknown, post 1907 G.C. fire)
Only walls remaining in 1950's, only burnt logs in 2024, (burnt to pan ashes for gold)

Building 8, behind Block B (on Shatford St.)

Log chicken house, Cook Estate (1922)
Occupied by Bill Churchill in 1953
No remains in 1985

Building 9, Lean-to beside #8

Bill Churchill's Woodshed in 1953
No remains in 1985
