- My apologies for not sending out a Report earlier, but as you will find out when you read this, you will see we have been busy behind the scenes.
- On July 20, Bob Sterne and I put 200 more maps in the mailbox at the Granite Creek Town Site. The total this year is now 400. On the same day we decided to fix the Granite Creek Cemetery sign. It was falling over. We donated a half a bag of concrete and a half a bag of mortar. That plus some water will hopefully make the sign stand straight for some time.
- Bob has been working very hard to get us some money to repair the Delprato roof, re-roof the old sauna at the site, get a new picnic table, have the garbage trucked out, order and mount a sign indicating where the Cabin and old Wagon Road are, and get new wood for the Cemetery fences that need repairing. He managed to get us a grant for \$2,450.00 from the Heritage Branch. There was a ton of paperwork for him to wade through. Great work Bob!!! Bob has contacted Ray from All Purpose Roofing who will be in charge of the repairs, and Ernie Rice who will do the rest. If Ernie can't stain the picnic table and paint the wood for the fences, we will need volunteers for that. The projects must be completed by the end of November. Any work at the Delprato Cabin will have to be done by mid-October before the weather makes the road impassable.
- We have not been up to the Cabin recently due to the high fire risk, however, we will go up and make sure things are in order before the above work begins.
- Dawn Gardner and I will set a date for the AGM once we have spoken with the Museum to ensure availability for it. I will let you know as soon as we have a day set.
